Vision Beyond Borders recently shipped 2,200 Spanish Bibles to Venezuela and the people were very grateful! Our next goal is to send another 4,600 Bibles. We will soon print 20,000 more Spanish Bibles. These will be printed and shipped from Spain which will hold our cost down to \$3.69 per Bible. Vision Beyond Borders, along with another ministry, hope to deliver a total of 120,000 Bibles to Venezuela by the end of 2019.

Recently a friend from Venezuela shared this story about her sister, a new believer in Christ, who was given a Bible. A man had broken into her home and said he would kill her and her family if she didn't give him her money. This lady told him she would not give him any money. She said he had to leave her home because he was a man of Satan and, she rebuked him in the name of Jesus. He ran away! It's exciting to hear how this new believer is relying on God to give her boldness and strength. The gift of a Bible helps believers like her to continue to grow in their walk with the Lord despite the suffering and danger around them. It would also be our prayer that the truth of God's Word would bring non-new believers to Him during this difficult time in Venezuela.
