

Spanish Bible Project

In the words of Augustine of Hippo,
"The Holy Scriptures are our letters from home."

Everywhere throughout the world, people are crying out for these letters. They long for the life-giving words of our Lord and Savior, yet they lack the means or abilities to obtain them. As Christians, we are called to carry the good news of the gospel to the ends of the earth and use our abundant resources to provide for our brother and sisters who have not.

Founded in 1994, Vision Beyond Borders began as a small ministry carrying Bibles into China and other parts of Asia. The ministry has since grown to support orphaned children, widows, persecuted pastors, and to rescue women and children from sex-slavery. Since its foundation, VBB has carried over 1 million Bibles into closed countries, set up rescue and rehabilitation ministries for sex-trafficking victims, provided for over 800 children and 200 pastors in Gospel-resistant nations, and administered humanitarian aid and medical care to the poor and persecuted refugees in Southeast Asia and the Middle East.

To carry on the central mission of delivering God's Word into the hands of His lost Children, Vision Beyond Borders is partnering with ministries in the nations of Venezuela, Honduras, and Nicaragua to import and distribute 200,000 Spanish Bibles.



The ministry in Honduras that VBB has come along side and partnered with is called Project Love. Through their mobilization of local congregations in the city of Choluteca, Project Love has began placing Bibles in the Honduran Public schools and providing Biblical, Godcentered teaching for the first fifteen minutes of each school day. To date, thirty schools in Honduras have opened their doors to this program, and Project Love longs to introduce this program to every school in the city of Choluteca in the next seven years. Through the process, they will distributing over 50,000 Bibles to children seeking to know the love of their Heavenly Father, and we have committed to providing those Bibles.

In addition to the 50,000 Bibles for Project Love, another 55,000 Bibles will be distributed to other partners in Honduras, while 75,000 will be delivered to Venezuela and 23,000 to the nation of Nicaragua.

We are able to print each Spanish Bible for \$3.21, and our goal is to secure 200,000 Bibles for distribution throughout these South American nations, costing a total of \$642,000 USD.

We ask you to prayerfully consider joining us in our endeavor to place the living and active Word of God into the hands of every man, woman, and child.
