

KiKi's Surgery

KiKI is a young girl living in Ms. Emerald's home in Burma who was born without kneecaps. Her parents passed away when she was very young, leaving her with no one to care for her. Miss Emerald has taken her in and loved her as her own for the majority of her life. On a recent trip to Burma the VBB team was introduced to this loving little girl. Her birth defect makes it nearly impossible for her to walk or attend school with the other children. She guickly stole our hearts. Since Miss Emerald's Home already cares for 147 children, they don't have the funding for large medical expenses. Vision Beyond Borders has taken on this project and is excited to witness how God's love will change this little girl's life. For KiKi's initial exam our contacts took her to a doctor in Yangon. The hospital in Yangon is not capable of performing such a detailed surgery, so they consulted with a larger hospital in Bangkok. The doctors there will replace her knee caps and turn her feet forward in a series of surgeries which are scheduled to begin in July. The cost for this procedure will total around \$33,000. VBB supporters have already given over \$18,000 leaving ~\$15,000 still to be raised.
