





# VISION FOR PASTORS

Our hearts rejoice whenever we receive updates from the pastors we support in Vietnam, Venezuela, Cuba, and Nepal. But we also suffer with them for their persecution for their faith in Jesus Christ, lack of basic needs, etc. A pastor in Vietnam, whose name we reserved for security reasons, wrote and asked us to pray for him and the brethren in that region. Though the pandemic has slowed, inflation and unemployment have made life worse for many, especially those like him who already live in poverty. Many false teachers are taking advantage of the suffering of the people. This teaching has spread to the Christians in the region, including people from his congregation who have fallen and are now following them.



Our brethren in Cuba continue to work for the Lord despite their many limitations and pressure from the communist government. We recently received a testimony from a pastor impacting hospitals and nursing homes in that region. They have powerful times of worship in these places. He wrote: "In a communist system, entering a state institution and holding a church meeting to worship God is highly unlikely, and if we have succeeded, it is because God has performed a miracle." He told us that a few weeks ago, they prayed for dozens of patients, and the following day the doctor was surprised at the improvement in the patients and discharged 80% of those hospitalized. **GLORY TO GOD!!!**



We thank God for all the pastors working hard to share the Gospel. They prepare sermons and Bible lessons to preach and teach to the church members. They visit members who need prayer, and they give family counseling, and direct church services, perform baptisms, weddings, and funerals. They are engaged in evangelism efforts to reach non-Christians. They are concerned with training leaders and making disciples. There are so many stories and testimonies that we receive from the pastors that VBB supports. We can see that it is the grace of God in them, as Paul wrote: "By the grace of God I am what I am; his grace has not been barren in me, but I have worked more than all of them. But, not me but the grace of God that is with me ". (1 Corinthians 15:10)
