

We are thrilled to share some incredible testimonies from a recent mission trip to the Dominican Republic. Reyna, who works with Vision Beyond Borders, shared these impactful stories from a children's church camp that highlight the power of faith, community, and God's provision.

## A Miraculous Provision

Pastor Enrique, who was in charge of transporting the children to the camp, experienced a miracle that highlights God's perfect timing and provision. On the day he was to pick up the kids, he felt something off with the van. Despite being very sick, he decided to check the tires after receiving an offering from VBB for the camp. They visited four different places before finally finding a shop that checked the tires and discovered they were on the verge of exploding. Thanks to the offering, Pastor Enrique was able to buy four new tires, ensuring the safety of the children. The kids were overjoyed, declaring, "It was the Lord's van!"

## Frank's Illness Ignites Faith

Another touching story comes from Frank, who faced severe illness during the trip. For two days, he couldn't eat and was in dire need of electrolytes to stay hydrated. Despite his health struggles, Frank shared his testimony about his children, revealing how God miraculously brought his two eldest children back to faith. However, his youngest daughter was still resistant to God's call.

During his illness, Frank's wife urged their youngest daughter to pray for him. Despite her initial reluctance, she agreed and attended church with her mother. That day, she repented and experienced a transformation, leading her to the altar in tears. Frank, upon seeing the photo of his daughter at the altar, was overwhelmed with emotion. He realized that his illness and trip had a divine purpose: to bring his daughter back to God. This story moved everyone, reminding us that when we take care of God's business, He takes care of ours.



## Francois' Perseverance

Reyna also met Francois, a Haitian who faced significant challenges during the camp. After receiving news of his sister's critical illness, he traveled to Haiti, where he prayed for her, and she miraculously recovered. However, his return to the Dominican Republic was hindered by legal issues, leading to two days in jail. Despite this, Francois found joy in reading the Bible in jail, relating his experience to Paul's imprisonment for Christ. His story of perseverance and faith was a testament to God's presence in all circumstances.
