At Vision Beyond Borders, we are blessed to support several children's homes in the challenging regions of Burma, Southeast Asia, India, and Nepal. Despite the turmoil, thanks to your unwavering support, these homes continue to flourish!

BURMA: HOPE IN THE MIDST OF CONFLICT



Burma is still grappling with internal conflict, but in the heart of it all, our children's homes are beacons of hope. The children are thriving—attending school, participating in church activities, playing sports, and enjoying music. Despite the challenges, such as the Burmese army occupying Shekinah Children's Home and landmines nearby, we praise God that all the children are safe, staying with families in a “safe” area close to each other. Our dedicated contact is ensuring they are cared for and fed with your support.

SOUTHEAST ASIA: A GROWING FAMILY

At Freedom House, we've recently welcomed 40 new children from the Karenni ethnic group, fleeing the war in the Karenni State. These children arrived traumatized, having lived in jungle IDP camps without education, healthcare, or sufficient food. Our contact, moved by their plight, agreed to take them in, trusting that God will provide for the increased monthly needs. We now support 60 children, and with your help, we're giving them a brighter future.



INDIA: RESILIENCE AND JOY



In India, our children are hard at work, playing, reading the Bible, and memorizing verses. They take great pride in keeping their surroundings clean and attending church regularly. By God's grace, they are excelling in their studies and recently passed their term exams! However, they face challenges with water, electricity, and infrastructure, and we're praying for solutions to these pressing needs.

NEPAL: A SAFE HAVEN FOR MANY



Esther's Home in Nepal has become a true sanctuary for girls, offering them a safe place to grow and thrive. The girls are doing wonderfully, enjoying school, and actively participating in church, with many joining the choir. Their love for writing, music, and dance shines brightly, making Esther's Home a place of joy and creativity.

Meanwhile, the mission continues to flourish in Asha, Nepal. This home supports 47 beneficiaries, including children and women at Godavari and 22 children at Hetauda. All the children are attending school and college and recently achieved excellent grades in their first-term exams. With the recent expansion of the complex, Asha Nepal can now provide refuge for even more women and children escaping sex trafficking—a vital effort made possible by your generous support.

As we approach Orphan Sunday, we invite you to join us in prayer for these precious souls. May the Lord continue to light their path through the darkness and bless our contacts with the grace and resources needed to welcome even more children into their loving care.
