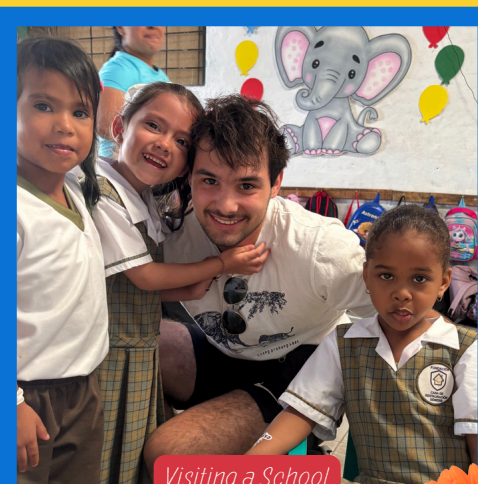
# MISSIONS TRIP TO COLOMBIA



**WHAT BEGAN AS A MISSION TO SUPPORT LOCAL PASTORS EXPANDED INTO A POWERFUL OUTREACH TOUCHING LIVES IN SHELTERS, RECOVERY HOMES, SCHOOLS, AND BEYOND.**

"What stood out to me the most was how open and receptive the people were to hearing the Gospel and receiving prayer. There's a deep brokenness in the country, heavily impacted by the drug trade and the struggles within the government. On our first day, we saw smoke rising from a bus that had been set on fire during a protest—an intense introduction to the realities the people face. Yet, in the midst of all that, there was such a hunger for truth and a better way of life. One of my favorite moments was visiting a children's school tucked away in a rough area in the mountains of Cali, Colombia. The kids were so full of love and joy—it was contagious. We had the privilege of praying over the teachers, and many of them were visibly moved, with tears in their eyes as they felt the love of Jesus. God's presence was so tangible. His hand is definitely at work in Colombia."

"One of the most meaningful highlights for me was the opportunity to pray for people after the services. The people were so eager and grateful to receive prayer—it was truly humbling. At the last church where we preached, they invited us to stay and pray for individuals one by one, even providing interpreters to help us communicate. My interpreter happened to be an 8-year-old girl. Toward the end of our time together, she gently stopped me and said, "Can you please pray for me? I want Jesus!" My heart was so moved. It was beautiful to see how, after helping others encounter God through prayer, she recognized her own desire for Him. That moment will stay with me—it was such a powerful reminder of how God works through even the smallest hearts."

"Our team included Patrick Klein and two families, with five youth ages 13 to 21, and their impact was undeniable. In schools and churches, the students were especially drawn to the young people, moved to see Americans their age boldly sharing their faith and testimonies. It broke down stereotypes and opened hearts in ways we didn't expect. Though we ministered in areas that were often dangerous—with moments like hearing gunfire outside our hotel or encountering a cartel member—we were covered in God's peace and presence every step of the way.

What inspired us most were the local believers—pastors, teachers, and former addicts—who have given up comfort to serve in hard places, simply because they love Jesus. They are truly the hands and feet of Christ."

"Our local contact arranged for us to minister in areas that most tourists would never enter due to the danger, but we were confident that God was with us. The team ministered in two powerful outreach centers dedicated to serving the homeless and those struggling with addiction to drugs and alcohol. The Holy Spirit moved powerfully in our midst, and it was a blessing to see people respond to altar calls with a hunger for prayer and transformation. Most days, we ministered from morning to early afternoon, took a short break, and then headed to evening church services. All of this unfolded amid political demonstrations and unrest in the streets, and at times we had to avoid certain parts of the city. Yet through it all, God's presence and protection never left us."
