




Over the past few months, God has been writing a beautiful story in the mountains of Panama—one filled with open doors, hungry hearts, and children receiving Bibles in their schools for the very first time.

This past spring, a small team traveled to David, Panama, to train 13 indigenous pastors from remote mountain communities. Once gathered together, we had the privilege of opening the Scriptures with these faithful leaders, answering their questions, and encouraging them in their walk with Christ.

Many of them live in extreme poverty, worshipping in dirt-floor churches made of bamboo and tin, yet their hunger for God's Word is unmatched. Their worship and fervent prayers stirred our hearts and reminded us of the richness of faith that thrives even in hardship. These pastors represent a mission field of nearly 700,000 indigenous people, almost 20% of Panama's population.

LEGACY

The work among the Ngäbe-Buglé tribe has deep roots. In 1975, a young woman from the town of Volcán, Chiriquí Province, answered God's call to minister to these communities. Through decades of evangelism and church planting, the fruit of that calling has multiplied into eight churches, each discipling believers and raising up leaders for future generations.

The Comarca remains a remote and rugged region, where many live without electricity or running water. Yet the Gospel continues to reach into these valleys and mountain villages, bringing hope and transformation.

Years ago, during an outreach, 400 hot dogs and 140 Spanish Bibles were handed out in a village. The memory of elderly women lining up joyfully for a meal—and clutching their first Bible—still reminds us why this work matters.

OPEN DOORS

Recently, the Lord opened an extraordinary door: the opportunity to distribute Bibles and share testimonies in public secondary schools in the Comarca. This is a significant breakthrough to reach the next generation. While there are enough Bibles for the immediate need, more will soon be required as God continues to open doors.

We also visited a young pastor who was shepherding a small church in Ola, in the Comarca, and encouraged him with prayer and a gift of Bibles. These are the leaders who will carry the Gospel forward into the future.

LOOKINGAHEAD

Because of what God is doing, plans are already in place to return in November to train up to 30 pastors. Our vision is to build on the foundation of Christ, raise up new leaders, and see churches planted throughout these mountain communities.

Please join us in prayer for:

- Open hearts among the indigenous people of Panama
- Wisdom and strength for the pastors serving in remote areas
- Continued favor in the public schools
- Provision of Bibles for every person hungry for God's Word

We could not do this without your prayers and support. Together, we are seeing God's Kingdom advance among some of the most unreached people of Panama.
