

WHEN BORDERS CLOSE, GOD OPENS ANOTHER

In the nation of Iran, darkness cannot extinguish the hope of Jesus spreading.

The people live under constant pressure—from a regime that silences truth, punishes faith, and forbids the Word of God. Owning a Bible can cost a person their freedom—or even their life.

But behind the walls of fear and censorship, something incredible is happening.

Reports from the underground church reveal a growing spiritual hunger unlike anything seen in recent decades. Decades of oppression have failed to extinguish faith; instead, hearts are awakening. People are searching for truth, longing for peace, and questioning everything they've been taught.

ARMENIA: A GATEWAY TO THE GOSPEL

Armenia is one of the most strategic mission fields in the world. As one of Iran's few open neighbors, it has become a refuge—a meeting ground where the Gospel can be shared freely.

Our contact on the ground describes what's happening:

"Persians are pouring into Armenia daily—some for work, others as tourists. I recently visited Persian villages in the south that were once abandoned. Now they're full of Iranians who have come to find jobs. When we arrived, they flocked around us, eager to talk. After 5 PM, they have nothing to do and no one visits them, so we arranged a meeting for anyone interested in hearing the Gospel."

That evening, about twelve gathered. For the first time in their lives, they saw and held a Bible—a book that had been banned in their homeland. They listened as God's Word was read aloud, and they heard the name of Jesus, not as a prophet, but as Savior.

Our contact shared this powerful moment:

"I began by debunking the lies they had been taught about Christianity, Jesus, and the Bible. They agreed that they shouldn't learn about Christianity from mullahs, but from Christians themselves. Then, for the first time in their lives, they heard from God's Word:

'And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.' (Acts 4:12)"

Their response was overwhelming. They stayed long after the sermon, asking questions and wanting Bibles. Four even stayed overnight at the ministry house, hungry to learn more.

And the movement is spreading. That same weekend, at a local church in Yerevan, six more Iranians came to faith in Christ.

What's happening in Armenia is extraordinary. As the borders of Iran remain closed, the Lord is bringing the Iranian people out, where they can finally hear the truth.

These men and women are searching for what their government cannot offer: forgiveness, peace, and freedom in Christ. And Vision Beyond Borders is helping to meet them there.

Through our ministry partners in Armenia, Farsi Bibles are being distributed to the very people God is drawing out of darkness. Every Bible placed into an Iranian's hands is a miracle—a seed of hope carried back across the border into Iran.

But there's a great need for more. As our contact shared: "We need a larger gathering hall near the border. Our current ministry center is too far away, and I'm convinced that if we had a meeting place close to these villages, hundreds would come to hear the Gospel."

The door to Iran may be closed, but God has opened another—right at its border.
