Jesus Set My Son Free and Saved My Soul

My name is Ravi. I am a Hindu man from a small village in the Thar Desert. For most of my life, I followed the faith of my family. But seven months ago, everything changed because of one gift—the Holy Bible.

Before this, our home was filled with fear and sorrow. My youngest son, Ajay, was no longer the boy I had raised. For two years, he suffered greatly. At night, he would scream with a voice that did not sound like his own. His body would shake, and he would fall to the ground. He stopped eating. At times, he would hit his head against the wall or try to run into the desert alone. I felt completely helpless.

Then, seven months ago, a man named Eric came to our village and shared about Jesus Christ. He handed me a book and said, "This is the Word of God." It was a Bible in my own language. I took it out of respect and placed it on a shelf, not realizing it would soon change everything.

One night, Ajay's condition became very severe. He was screaming and foaming at the mouth. My wife was crying, and I did not know what to do. In that moment, I remembered the Bible. I took it down and began to read. My eyes fell on Romans 10:9: "If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." Right there in our small home, I knelt down in the sand. With tears in my eyes, I called on Jesus and asked Him to save me. I believed He died for my sins and rose again. In that moment, a peace I had never known filled my heart. As I continued reading, I came across these words in Mark 16:17: "In my name they will drive out demons." And in Luke 10:19: "I have given you authority... over all the power of the enemy."

For the first time, I understood that God had given me authority through Jesus. With trembling hands, I placed my hand on my son's head and prayed, "In the name of Jesus Christ, leave my son and never return." Ajay cried out one last time, then suddenly became still. A moment later, he opened his eyes and said, "Baba, I'm hungry." That night, for the first time in two years, he slept peacefully.

Since that day, my son has been completely free. He is healthy, full of joy, and back to being the boy I knew. Now, every evening, we sit together and read the Bible. One of our favorite passages is Matthew 8:16, where Jesus healed all who were brought to Him. Jesus did not only heal my son—He saved me first.

I am no longer ashamed. I want others in my village to know what Jesus has done. I have begun sharing with my neighbors. Some listen, and some are not happy, but I will continue to tell them the truth.

I am deeply thankful to Vision Beyond Borders for sending this Bible into my life. You did not know me, but God used your gift to reach my family. Because of you, my son is healed, I am saved, and we now have hope. Please pray for me to have the courage to continue sharing about Jesus with my people. The desert around us is dry—but my heart is now full of living water.

Those years were filled with pain and shame. I turned to alcohol and smoking just to numb the pain. I hated myself. I believed I was too sinful for God to love. Many times, I wanted to end my life, but I kept thinking of my family and continued on. For nine years, I lived this way. I had money, but no peace. I had clothes, but no joy. Inside, I felt empty—like I was already dead.

Then one day, I became very sick and could no longer work. I was thrown out onto the street with nothing. I sat near a bus stop and cried, with nowhere to go. A man came and sat beside me. He did not look at me with judgment. He gave me food and water and said, "Jesus loves you." I didn't believe him. I told him, "Jesus does not love someone like me." He placed a Bible in my hands and said, "Read this. God wants to speak to you." That night, I slept under a bridge. I was cold, alone, and afraid. With nothing else to hold onto, I opened the Bible.

For months, I read it every day. I read John 8:11, where Jesus tells a sinful woman, "Neither do I condemn you... Go and sin no more." I wept as I realized that He did not reject me. I read Psalm 40:2, "He lifted me out of the pit... out of the mud and mire." That was my life—a pit. I read Luke 7:47, where Jesus speaks of a sinful woman and says, "Her many sins have been forgiven—for she loved much." One night, under that bridge, I knelt and prayed, "Jesus, I am broken. I am full of sin. But if You can love me, please forgive me. Be my Lord. I don't want this life anymore." That night, something changed. For the first time, I felt clean—not on the outside, but in my heart. The next day, the man found me again and helped me leave that life behind.

Today marks two years. I am no longer living in that darkness. I work in a small shop, and I am learning new skills like sewing. Life is still not easy, and I still face reminders of my past, but now I have hope. When I struggle, I hold onto God's promises. Isaiah 1:18 says, "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow." Jesus has made me new. I want other women to know this truth: no one is too far gone. Jesus came for the broken. He says in Matthew 11:28, "Come to me... and I will give you rest." And He has given me rest.

Thank you to those who placed that Bible in my hands when I had no hope. Thank you to Vision Beyond Borders and those who help send God's Word into places of darkness. I was once trapped in sin. Now I am a daughter of the King. Please pray for me and for the many women who are still living in that same darkness—that they too would find hope and freedom in Jesus.



Jesus Pulled Me Out Of Darkness



My name is Jameela. I am 27 years old. For many years, my life was filled with darkness. I was trapped in prostitution. This was not a life I chose. When I was 17, my father died, and everything changed. Our family was left with debt we could not repay. We were living in bonded labor, unable to leave because of what was owed. My mother was very sick and unable to work. We had no food, no money, and no way out. My younger brothers were hungry, and I was afraid.

One day, a man approached my mother and promised me a good job in the city. He said I would work in a hotel and could send money home. My mother believed him. I was only 17 and did not understand what was happening. There was no hotel. I was sold into a place where I was forced to work. I was beaten and threatened. They told me if I tried to escape, my family would be harmed. So I stayed.
